

### **Unit LD310 - Understand how to support individuals with autistic spectrum**

One Day Induction Course and Assessment in the Workplace

#### **Who is it for?**

Members of Durham Employers Care and Health Alliance (Decha) and staff from County Durham Care and Support within Durham County Council who are involved with adults affected by autistic spectrum

#### **Aims**

The unit provides a range of knowledge and understanding about autistic spectrum conditions and explores theories and concepts about autism. It enables learners to reflect on the impact of these conditions on the lives of individuals and those close to them and to learn about good practice in areas such as communication and support.

- Understand the main characteristics of autistic spectrum conditions
- Understand how autistic spectrum conditions can impact on the lives of individuals and those around them
- Understand different theories and concepts about autism
- Understand the legal and policy framework that underpins good practice in the support of individuals with autistic spectrum conditions
- Understand how to achieve effective communication with individuals with an autistic spectrum condition
- Understand how to support individuals with an autistic spectrum condition
